

Rules & Terms and Conditions - Beat the Burger

The Beat the Burger challenge will be held on Saturday 24th February at 11am at Mount Sheridan Plaza in the food court.

The Best the Burger challenge will have 4 different categories, **Beat the Heat, The Full Deal, The Big Boy Challenge and Down the Dog.**

The Beat the Burger contest will be limited to 10 contestants per round/category. Applicants will be accepted on a first come first serve basis, the first 10 registration forms received and paid in full will be considered the contestants. Except the Big Boy Challenge, this is 5 contestants only.

To enter contestants must complete the application form on the Mount Sheridan Plaza website at www.mtsheridanplaza.com.au, visit Apex Milk Bar Express at Mount Sheridan or collect an application form from the Mount Sheridan Plaza centre management office.

Registration for the Contest will begin on Monday 19th February 2018 at 9:00am.

Entry fee is \$10 per participant and this money will be donated to the Edmonton Men's Shed. Entry is open to all individuals over the age of 12 years who reside in Cairns and or the surrounding suburbs from Cardwell to Mossman

Contestants may participate in one category only.

Each contestant will be scheduled for a specific time to compete and any contestant who is more than 5 minutes late will be disqualified. All contestants are to arrive in the food court at the registration desk 20 minutes prior to their allocated category time and will be asked to provide ID matching your application form.

11:10am – Category 1 **Beat the Heat**

11:25am - Category 2 **The Full Deal**

11:40am – Category 3 **The Big Boy Challenge**

11:55am – Category 4 **Down the Dog**

1st Prize \$200.00 + Trophy in all 4 categories, total prize pool \$800 cash.

Category 1 - Beat the Heat

Each contestant will be given 2 burgers that will be placed in front of them. The contestant who consumes the most food in 10 minutes will win!

Spicy Piggy

Category 2 - The Full Deal

The first contestant to finish the entire meal including loaded burger, chips and 375ml can of soft drink will win the major prize.

Burger - Wizard of Oz

Beef pattie, egg, pineapple, cheese, bacon

Category 3 – The Big Boy Challenge

5 Contestants will have 15 minutes to consume the Big Boy Challenge. The contestant who consumes the most food will be deemed the winner and will be awarded the major prize.

After the 15 minutes a whistle will be blown and there will be a 30 second window to finish what is still within the contestant's mouth. No further bites may be taken on the final whistle.

Burger – The Big Boy Challenge

Category 4 - Down the Dog

All contestants must be aged between 12 and 18 years of age

The first contestant to consume 2 Apex Hotdogs in the quickest time will win the major prize.

The runner up (2nd place) from each category will receive a \$50 Apex Gift Voucher

Rules

A whistle will be blown to begin each category and for **The Big Boy Challenge** a whistle will be blown to let contestants know that there is 1 minute remaining

The employees of each Administrator and Sponsor, their respective parent company, affiliates, subsidiaries, and any other company involved with the production and execution of the Contest, and their household members and immediate family members, are not eligible to participate in the Contest

No leaving the table

No sharing

Beat the Heat, The Full Deal and The Big Boy Challenge all contestants must be 18 years of age and over

The employees of each Administrator and Sponsor, their respective parent company, affiliates, subsidiaries, and any other company involved with the production and execution of the Contest, and their household members and immediate family members, are not eligible to participate in the Contest

Each contestant will be provided with a 600ml bottle of water that they may consume at their own will through the competition

You must open your mouth and place your hands in the air to show that you are completely finished.

In the event that a registered contestant has not shown up a member from the audience will have the opportunity to participate after reading all rules, terms and conditions and have signed the release waiver.

Burgers/hotdog must be eaten whole, one after the other. Only after the previous burger/hotdog is completely in the contestants mouth (including any dropped ingredients on the plate) can the person start eating the next burger/hotdog.

In the event of a tie, the tied contestants will be given 1 more burger/hotdog and the quickest to eat the burger/hotdog will win the major prize.

In the event of a tie, any partly eaten burger will be investigated by a member of Mount Sheridan Plaza staff and the entrant with the smallest amount of burger/hotdog left, will win.

Grounds for disqualification include:

1. False or incomplete entry form or release waiver.
2. Health risks that could jeopardize the contestant's health or wellbeing.
3. Under the influence of any substance or alcohol.
4. Attire and footwear that is deemed inappropriate.
5. Starting prior to the start signal.
6. Continuing to put food in the mouth after the ending signal.
7. Throwing up or regurgitating.

Any contestant that vomits within the 2 minutes of the completion of their respective category will be disqualified.

Food cannot be touched or manipulated by eaters prior to the start

Any food that passes the lips into the mouth must stay in the mouth

Mount Sheridan Plaza staff members will be on site to answer any queries and provide children with a fun environment. This is not a child minding facility and children should be supervised at all times by parent/guardian/carer.

This event is Free of Charge to enter.

Additional Food and or drink items are not permitted in the event area.

In order to participate, contestants, parents and or guardians must register each child at the registration table in centre court, each contestant will receive a name badge for participation in the event. All participants must be signed-in by their parent or guardian upon arrival, on the designated sheet provided.

Parents agree to take full responsibility allowing their children to participate in the Beat the Burger contest in Down the Dog Category 4.

Footwear must be worn at all times

All participants must follow instructions from staff.
