

## **Mount Sheridan Plaza Grocery Grab Competition - Terms & Conditions:**

Registration or participation in this competition is deemed the entrant's acceptance of these Terms & Conditions of Entry. Acceptance of these Terms & Conditions is a condition of entry into this competition.

### **PRIZES - DRAW DATES**

Grocery Grab will run at 8:00 am daily (weekdays) from Friday, 27th November to Thursday, 10th December 2020 at Mount Sheridan Plaza.

There are ten prizes and ten winners over ten days. Maximum awarded trolley value awarded prize is \$500 value. The total prize pool is \$5000.

At 12 noon daily, the selected prize winner will be drawn, contacted by phone and will have the opportunity to spend 1 minute in either Coles or Woolworths Mount Sheridan Plaza at 8 am the following day, and place as many groceries as they can grab within 60 seconds.

The winner will be contacted at 12 noon and will have until 2 pm that very same day to contact us back. If the winner does not make contact before 2 pm, another entrant will be contacted, and entrant will have from 2 pm-4 pm confirm. The process will be repeated until we reach a winner.

Entries will accumulate in barrels throughout the promotion. More frequent shoppers will have more chances to win.

Only one person can participate in the Grocery Grab at any time. However, there will be a staff member in close approximation to time and film the Grocery Run.

Mount Sheridan Plaza will nominate the major retailer in which the competition will be held as per below:

Coles / Mount Sheridan Plaza ONLY from Monday 30th November to Friday 4th December.

Woolworths / Mount Sheridan Plaza ONLY from Monday 7th December to Friday 11th December

If the nominated retailer cannot run the competition for whatever reason, the other retailer will be selected to facilitate the Grocery Grab.

### **DURATION**

Grocery Grab promotion will commence 9 am Friday 27th November 2020 and conclude 12noon Thursday 10th December 2020 to draw the last winner to run Friday 11th December at 8 am.

## **ELIGIBILITY**

1. Entry is open to residents of the Cairns Region from Atherton to Cardwell and all postcodes in-between aged 18 or over.
2. To obtain an entry entrant must make a minimum purchase of \$15.00 or more, in one transaction, at participating retailers within Mount Sheridan Plaza, write their name and phone number on the receipt and deposit their it into the entry barrels.
3. Employees and Retailers of Mount Sheridan Plaza and immediate families are ineligible to enter. "Immediate family member" means any parent, spouse, sibling, child, defacto or any other family member residing at the same address as that person.
4. To be eligible for the prize, the receipt must have the full name and phone number of the entrant written clearly and spend must be \$15.00 or more. Failure to meet these requirements will render the entry invalid. Incomplete or indecipherable entries will be deemed invalid.
5. Entries close on Thursday 10th December 2020 at noon AEST. Entries received after this time will not be eligible. The drawing of prizes will take place, in the presence of an independent witness; at noon AEST daily (excluding Saturdays and Sundays) from Friday 27th November to Thursday 10th December 2020 at Mount Sheridan Plaza.
6. The first entry drawn each day at random that meets all eligibility requirements will be the winner. No copies will be accepted. No responsibility will be taken for lost or misdirected entries.
7. The judge's decision is final and conclusive, and no comment or correspondence will be entered into.
8. The Winner will be notified by telephone after the competition draw. If the Promoter is unable to make contact with the winner within 2 hours (by 2:00pm) on the same day of the draw, then the prize will be forfeited and the Promoter will draw an alternative winner and attempt to make contact with that person for collection of the prize. The Promoter will continue in this fashion until a winner has been notified and has collected their prize.
9. The Winner must provide suitable identification to the Promoter's satisfaction to be entitled to claim the prize.
10. The prize is not transferable or refundable and is not redeemable for cash.
13. Entrants acknowledge that the Promoter has the right to publicise and publish his/her name and likeness. The winner must make himself/herself available for a photo if required and acknowledge that the Promoter has the right to use publicity photos in any reasonable manner it sees fit, without compensation to the winner.

17. It is a condition of accepting the prize that the winner may be required to sign a legal release prize letter
18. If the nominated winner cannot participate in the Grocery grab they may nominate an immediate family member to participate on their behalf
19. If the participant has more in their trolley, they may pay the difference after the \$500 maximum limit has been reached. Any goods over the value of \$500 will be returned to the store if the nominated entrant would not like to purchase them.

20. By entering the competition, the winner agrees to be filmed before, during and after the Grocery Grab. The content will be uploaded to the Mount Sheridan Plaza's Social Media Channels.
21. The Participant will be required to wear flat enclosed shoes.
22. The Grocery Grab will be timed and witnessed by a representative from the retailer involved in addition to a staff member from Mount Sheridan Plaza.
23. Should Mount Sheridan Plaza deem the competition conditions to be unsafe for any reason, they reserve the right to pause the competition. Once the hazard has been removed, the Grocery grab will recommence with the remaining time on the clock.
24. The Promoter and their associated agencies and companies will not be liable for any misadventure, accident, injury, loss (including but not limited to consequential loss) or claim suffered or brought by a Participant:
  - a) during the judging;
  - b) in their participation in this competition or in a prize;
  - c) as a consequence of late, lost or misdirected mail;
  - d) as a result of failure to comply with any of these terms and conditions; or,
  - e) due to the publication of any material, including any statements made by any staff member, journalist, other entrants or any other person.
25. The Participant will be required to arrive at least 15 mins before 8am for registration.
26. Tobacco and associated products, liquor and the purchase of Gift Cards are excluded as eligible items within the Grocery Grab.
27. Winners are drawn daily from the total entry pool, therefore, the more times your shop during the nominated competition period, the more chances you have to win.
28. You may only win in the 2020 Mount Sheridan Plaza Grocery Grab on one occasion. Therefore winners remaining entries will be null and void.
29. Faulty products or inferior goods must be returned to the retailer involved, the Promoter will not be involved in negotiations regarding any returned items.
30. In the event that the selected entry cannot be contacted for whatever reason, the prize will be forfeited, and we will draw another entry.
31. When the facilitator calls time is up at the end of the 60 seconds, any excess products placed in the trolley after this time will be returned to the shelf.

## **MECHANICS**

Entry barrels will be emptied each day at 12noon. Customers will have a 24 hour period to place their entry in the barrel each day.

The winner will be drawn at random from collated entries. Winner will then be contacted by phone and asked to come onsite to the Mount Sheridan Plaza Centre Management Office. Once registered, we will walk to Coles or Woolworths, and the winner will have the chance to place as many groceries in their trolley within the 60 second time limit.

## **CRITERIA**

If there is a dispute as to the identity of an entrant, the Promoter reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to determine the identity of the entrant.
