

## **Terms and Conditions – Slime of your Life**

The Paramour Theatre will be at Mount Sheridan Plaza from Monday 11<sup>th</sup> of January to Friday 15<sup>th</sup> April 2020 with 2 FREE shows daily at 10:00am and 12:00pm.

Children must remain seated during the show unless called upon by the hosts for participation.

Entry is on a first come first admitted basis, booking is essential via:

The shows will involve audience participation. Teams are selected at random by the Paramour Theatre's show host. Where possible teams will consist of a family unit.

Winning teams will be awarded a prize hamper of approximately \$100 from Mount Sheridan Plaza. The losing teams will be covered in slime.

### **Slime ingredient information:**

Ingredients Water, Corn flower, Caster Sugar, Maize Thickenner (1422), Mineral Salts (339, 450), Vanilla Flavour, Salt, Colours (102,110). Green and yellow food colouring.

Allergen may be present Egg | Milk | Sesame | Soy | Tree Nuts | Wheat.

Protective gear will be provided for contestants being slimed. Mount Sheridan Plaza will not assume any liability for clothing discoloured, damaged or altered during the course of the event.

Seating is limited; please allow elderly or infirm first preference on seats.

Children will have priority over adult attendance.

Shows are approximately 40 minutes with a 50 person capacity.

Parents agree to take full responsibility after allowing their children into the activity area and for their participation in the performance and games.

Footwear must be worn – any children that have entered the area without footwear do so at their own risk it is responsibility of parents to ensure child has adequate foot protection.

Each Session will have its own sets of Costumes. Equipment will be sanitised between the two teams and between the two daily shows. Costumes will be laundered at the end of each day.

### **NOT RECOMMENDED FOR :**

Children less than 6 years old

Persons with allergies to slime ingredients (Listed above).

Parents / Guardians of children must sign overleaf in acceptance of these terms and conditions before children will be allowed into the performance space.
