All participants are required to register at the entrance to attend the event, registration is for child participants only aged 3-16 years of age.

Personal details will be taken on registration. Name, child's name, suburb, phone number and email address and a time slot allocated. There is no need to present ticket on entry into the activity/workshop area as there will be a list of all registered attendees.

Children misbehaving will be removed from the area, for their safety and the safety of others.

Any complaints will need to be referred to the contractor providing the event entertainment – details can be obtained for the Centre Management Office.

Listen to the workshop advisor, listen for directions thoroughly before beginning any project. That includes both the directions for the project and any labels on products you may be using.

All the materials you will need are in one place. Accidents can occur when you're hurriedly looking for something.
