Dates:

April 11-15, 2023 with 5 free shows daily at 10:00am, 10:45am, 11:30am, 12:45pm and 1:30pm.

Tickets:

All participants entering the dome require a ticket. Tickets are free and available online from the Mt Sheridan Plaza website provided by “Sticky Tickets”. Tickets may be shown on the day however staff will have an attendance list printed.

Walk-ins are subject to availability on the day and this is managed by event staff at the dome. Obtaining a ticket (including for anyone under 18) is your acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.

This show is not recommended for children under 3 years of age, with their entry being their parent/guardian’s decision.

General Terms & Conditions:

- Participants must abide by the instructions given by staff managing the event at all times.
- There is no exiting the dome once the show begins unless in the case of an emergency.
- No food or drinks or shoes worn are allowed in the dome area.
- Mobile phones are to be switched off during shows & not used inside the event area.
- Participants must remain seated on the floor during the show.
- Shows have loud sounds and dramatic visual effects including possible flashing lights – this may be unsuitable for some children or those with sensitivities.
- Shows are approximately 30 minutes with a 25 person capacity.
- Parents agree to take full responsibility after allowing their children into the activity area.
- Children may be left to enjoy show without their parent/guardian, however adults must be back on time to collect their child prior to the end of the 30 minute session.
- Any issues must be directed to the staff managing the event.
- If you or any member of your family is unwell please do not enter the event/activity area.
